














Join us! It's a great opportunity to:

- Reconnect with nature and culture in Yucatan enjoying the landscapes, haciendas and archaeological sites in search of the largest number of birds.
- Enjoy a unique and different experience with your family, friends and work colleagues.
- Know, value and protect birds and their natural habitat such as jungles and wetlands.

What is the bird marathon?

The Xoc Ch'ich' Bird Marathon ("bird count" in Mayan) is a team competition in which those who observe and record the largest number of bird species in a period of 29 hours will be the winners.

Form your team of 3 to 7 people (friends, family, co-workers, etc.) **PLUS** a specialist bird guide. You can also contact the Organizing Committee to be integrated into a team. All teams **WITHOUT EXCEPTION** must incorporate a **local guide specialized in bird watching**, who will guarantee that the species observed are correctly identified.

Important

On the bird festival website www.festivalavesyucatan.com you will find a list of specialized local bird guides, willing to share their knowledge and experience.



Select your category:

- Classic: suitable for those who have already participated previously or practice the activity regularly. It is recommended for those who want to visit different habitats and take longer tours.
- 1. **Beginners:** suitable for first-time participants and those who want to take shorter tours. It is recommended for those who observe birds sporadically (or have never done so) and want to gain experience.





Sign up your team. Pay your registration via bank transfer, deposit or in cash (see payment information at the end of the document):

General public: \$340 MXN (\$19 USD) PER PERSON.

Students: \$210 MXN (\$12 USD) PER PERSON.

Important

All team members (including the guide) must cover their registration fee.

The payment of the recovery fee includes: Event kit (t-shirt and official list of the birds of Yucatan) and closing breakfast. **NOT included:** Lodging, transportation, food and payment to the guide.

The registration fee payment is exclusively for registered participants, the event is closed to the general public, so for logistical participation in activities will not be granted to external people who are not registered (drivers, companions of the participants, people without an invitation to the activity, etc.).





Teams must establish a **route within the State of Yucatan to observe birds**. They can rely on their guide to prepare it. They will be able to tour jungles, wetlands and communities, enjoying a weekend full of spectacular natural landscapes, exquisite regional cuisine and the warmest treatment by the community.





Important

As you plan your route, please keep in mind that officially all bird watching activities should begin on **Saturday November 22nd at 5:00 am** and that team bird lists will be submitted at the closing venue on **Sunday November 23rd BEFORE 10:00 am**.

BIRD LISTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 10:00 AM. WITHOUT EXCEPTION.
